MINUTES

MATTERS ARISING

556/2020 Field Opposite Bronllys Garage – As now reply in writing has been received the Clerk has asked Mr. David Chadwick, MP for Brecon and Radnor to take this forward.

633/2024 Welsh Water, Llyswen – An update from Welsh Water has been received as follows. Welsh Water will be continuing the laying of the new pipe along the A479 in Llyswen Village between the 11th November and 22nd November, and then 6th – 20th December, with two way lights in place at certain sections.

From the 6th January, 2025 – 24th January, 2025 they will be working further along the A479. To protect the public and the safety of the workers there will be a road closure on the A479 with the section closed near Llyswen petrol station. Access will still be in place for residents, emergency vehicles and refuse collection.

624/2024 Cutting of Verges, Pontywal Lane – Cllr Evans reported that he is going to take photographs and send them in to Powys County Council.

644/2024 Bus Shelter, Bronllys – It was agreed that this would continue to be monitored.

646/2024 Junction Bridgend, Llyswen – Cllr Colbert reported that Highways have agreed to look at the junction by the Bridgend Inn. However, they have stated there is no problem with the bridge.

649/2024 Pontybat Junction – Cllr Colbert reported that he has written to the First Minister and the Transport Minister, however has had a reply saying that it does not meet the criteria at the moment for a roundabout and also due to budgetary constraints this is not a feasible project.

650/2024 Hedge, War Memorial, Llyswen – Cllr Hughes reported that the hedge has now been cut.
